FESTIVAL INFORMATION

The 37th annual Art and the Vineyard Festival, presented by Maude Kerns Art Center, is the premier art and wine festival in the Southern Willamette Valley. In 2024 the festival takes place **Friday through Sunday**, **July 5**, **6**, **& 7**.

The festival draws over 20,000 attendees and includes Art For Your Garden, the Artists' Marketplace, a Wine Court, an International Food Court, Youth Art Arena, Youth Stage, and the Main Stage.

Festival Mission:

To present the premier art and wine festival in the Southern Willamette Valley.



ART FOR YOUR GARDEN

The Art For Your Garden area includes artworks within a unique landscape design to emphasize the beauty in nature and to provide ideas on how to incorporate art objects in a garden setting.

Handcrafted arbors and trellises, stone and metal sculpture, fountains, and birdbaths are placed in appropriate, aesthetic settings to suggest to buyers that art does belong in gardens, on porches, and by pathways.

WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

Garden furniture, pottery, planters, urns, tiles, masks, birdbaths, fountains, bird feeders and houses, wind chimes, lanterns, sculptures, kiosks, sundials, window boxes, gates, and abstract pieces. Suggestions of additional imaginative work are welcome. There is no limit to the number of pieces that accepted artists can exhibit for sale.

Artists interested in applying are requested to supply a CD or thumb drive with (4) images in **jpeg format** that are most representative of artwork to be displayed at the festival. It should be marked clearly and legibly with the artist's name and business name (if applicable). Individual image files should be labeled with the artist's name and the titles of works.

Maude Kerns Art Center reserves the right to use selected images for publicity and promotion purposes, with credit given to the artist.

SELECTION PROCESS

Art and the Vineyard is open to all artists and craftspeople producing original art. Commercially produced work, art assembled from kits, or imported art and goods will not be accepted. The festival seeks the finest quality artwork through the jury process.



A panel of experienced art professionals will jury selections based solely on the quality and creativity of work represented in the images submitted by each artist-applicant. All interested artists, including past participants, are required to submit an application and images.

APPLICATION FEE \$15

There is a \$15 application fee for all applicants.

FEES

There will be a **30% commission** on all Art For Your Garden art sales. Maude Kerns Art Center will handle all sales at the event and will issue artists a check within thirty days of the close of the event. Your commission helps support the year-round arts programming at Maude Kerns Art Center.

Insurance

Participating artists must provide proof of property and liability insurance or sign an appropriate release holding harmless the Maude Kerns Art Center and the event manager in the event of loss, damage, or theft during the festival. Security is provided.
